## Wine Industry in the Occupied Golan Heights

#### Introduction:

In June 1967, after the fall of the Golan Heights under Israeli occupation, the majority of its residents were forcibly expelled, and their villages destroyed.

In September of the same year, just weeks after the expulsion of the displaced population, the occupation authorities established the first settlement — *Merom Golan* — on lands belonging to the displaced Syrians.

This step confirms that Israel, which had planned from the outset to seize the Golan Heights when it waged war against Syria, aimed to keep the territory under its control.

Today, the number of settlements established by the occupation authorities on lands it seized in 1967 has reached 35, including one small city (*Katzrin*, population <u>9,422</u>) and 34 agricultural settlements (total population <u>22,185</u>).

The settlements were built on the ruins and lands of the destroyed Syrian villages.

The creation of settlements required the establishment of an economic infrastructure nearby to ensure their stability and development, attract more settlers, and maintain full geographic control over the Golan.

Settlers, alongside the military, play a security role in controlling the land and the indigenous population.

Due to the abundance of water resources and fertile soil in the Golan, the settlement economy is dominated by agriculture. All settlements rely primarily on farming, except for Katzrin and Bene Yehuda.

Tourism has been developed as the second most important sector, while industry ranks third, with industrial centers established in Katzrin and Bene Yehuda.

The wine sector in the occupied Golan is an old industry linked to the Zionist settlement project, which took root on lands seized by Israel in 1967 after a campaign of ethnic cleansing that displaced about 95% of the Golan's original Syrian population and destroyed their villages.

### Wine in Israel:

A review of Hebrew literature in Israel reveals a narrative that links the development of the wine industry to the Zionist settlement project, portraying it as part of a historical continuum of winemaking in the region going back thousands of years.

"Agriculture has existed in Israel for about ten thousand years, and participated in the agricultural revolution... Throughout the country there is evidence of agricultural settlements, agricultural methods and varieties... The most prominent example of this is the remains of Nabataean agriculture in the Negev. For thousands of years, the economy in Israel has been based on agriculture and trade" (1).


In other sources we read:

"The history of wine production in Israel began in ancient times, with some interruptions from then until the present day.... During the Roman era, development continued, and wine quality improved, and it was better preserved after the discovery of cork. After the Muslim conquest in the seventh century, winemaking in Israel ceased for a long time." )2(

Today, Israel's wine production plays a secondary role in its economy, ranking <u>131</u>st globally in exports, but enjoys prestigious recognition in terms of quality, especially wines produced in the Golan Heights due to its favorable soil and climate.

The cultivated land area in Israel amounts to <u>4.1</u> million dunams, of which more than <u>60,000</u> dunams are used for grape cultivation, producing approximately <u>45,000</u> tons of grapes. Wine production is distributed among more than <u>350</u> wineries, which in turn produce <u>40</u> million bottles of wine (30 million liters), worth approximately <u>1.0</u> billion shekels. In addition, approximately <u>20</u> million bottles of unfermented juice are produced.

About <u>20%</u> of the wine produced (approximately **6 million liters**) is marketed abroad and exported to approximately <u>50</u> **countries** around the world, including two Arab countries: the UAE and Morocco.

As the table above shows, in 2024, Israel's wine exports were valued at approximately **USD 66.63 million**. The United States ranked first in Israeli wine consumption, accounting for **72%** of the total, valued at approximately **USD 48 million**. The European Union countries ranked second, accounting for over **20%**.

(1) the total Agricultural area of Snir Settlement is **4,115** Dunam. **2,147** Dunam located in Galilea, outside of Golan.

The table above shows that the agricultural lands exploited by the settlements in the Golan amount to about **104,000 dunams**, of which around **15,000 dunams** (14%) are used for vineyards. The remainder is used for other tree crops (apples, cherries, peaches, mangoes, etc.), flowers, berries (strawberries, raspberries), and field crops (grains, vegetables).

The annual value of the Golan settlements' agricultural products exceeds <u>1.50</u> billion shekels (around **USD 450 million**).

A 1973 report by Professor Cornelius Ough of the University of California, Davis, concluded — after a visit to Israel in 1972— that the Golan's soil and climate were ideal for wine grape cultivation.

In 1976, the first vineyards were planted in the occupied Golan, and in 1983, the Golan Heights Winery produced its first wines under the slogan "Quality Above All." )3(

Israel has over <u>300</u> wineries, **23** of which are located in settlements in the occupied Golan. These wineries produce about **7 million bottles** annually, **5.5 million** of which come from the Golan Heights Winery alone — representing **78%** of all Golan settlement production, while the remaining wineries' production ranges from a few thousand to hundreds of thousands of bottles (see table).

The **Golan Heights Winery** ranks third in Israeli wine production, with a market share (in 2021) of <u>18.9%</u>. **Carmel Winery** comes in second with a market share <u>of 23.6%</u>, and **Barkan Winery** comes in first with a market share of <u>24.3%</u>. In contrast, the Golan Heights Winery exports <u>20%</u> of its production abroad (to 32 countries), which is equivalent to <u>40%</u> of Israel's wine exports, making it the leading wine exporter.



### **Indication of Origin:**

In a 2015 interpretative notice issued by the European Commission regarding the reference to the origin of goods from the territories occupied by Israel since 1967, it stated: "Since the Golan Heights and the West Bank (including East Jerusalem) are not part of the Israeli territory according to international law, the reference to "product of Israel" is considered incorrect and misleading within the meaning of the legislation in question."

According to the Interpretation Notice, the origin indication for settlement products must state "Product of a settlement in the West Bank" or "Product of a settlement in the Golan Heights" or equivalent.


A 2020 EuMEP (European Middle East Project) study surveyed 3,089 settlement wines on sale in 189 shops across the EU.


In study entitled: <u>Waiting for enforcement</u>: <u>Origin indication of Israeli settlement wines on sale in</u> <u>the EU - February 2020</u>, (conducted by the non-profit organization EuMEP - European Middle East Project) which surveyed **189 stores** across the European Union selling **3,089 types of wine**, sourced from wineries located in settlements in the occupied territories.


#### Findings:

- 78% of the settlement wines sold in the European Union are from settlements in the Golan Heights.
- 22% came from West Bank settlements.
- Only 10% of settlement wines carried -according to EU rules- fully correct or partially correct origin labels (3% correct, 7% partially correct).
- 90% failed to comply with the EU interpretative notice and the European Court of Justice ruling.

These results demonstrate that EU countries have not complied with the Interpretive Notice and the European Court of Justice's ruling.







#### **Conclusion:**

Over the past two decades, Israeli wine exports have increased fivefold, from USD <u>13.35</u> million in 2004 to USD <u>66.3</u> million in 2024.

Wineries in the occupied Golan Heights lead Israel's wine exports, distinguished by the high quality of their wines, which are marketed in over 30 countries worldwide.

There are 23 wineries in Golan settlements, three of which dominate exports, led by the Golan Heights Winery in Katzrin, which accounts for **40%** of Israel's total wine exports. Other key exporters include Odem Winery (est. 2007 in Odem settlement, north Golan) and Domaine Seror Winery (in Avne Etan settlement, exporting <u>40%</u> of its production). It is estimated that Golan wines represent about **50%** of Israel's wine exports.

Recognizing the importance of the Golan to the wine industry, in 2010 the state established a winemaking department at the Ohalo Academic College in Katzrin, in cooperation with the <a href="CFPPA wine school in Beaune">CFPPA wine school in Beaune</a>, <a href="France">France</a>.

The settlement economy, including the wine sector, is supported by various government ministries — Agriculture, Industry, and Tourism.

Wineries serve as tourist attractions, hosting wine tastings and promoting themselves on digital tourism platforms such as **Booking.com**, often presenting settlement sites as Israeli tourist destinations — a practice that obscures the illegality of the settlement enterprise under international law.

In reality, the Golan wine industry is deeply tied to the Zionist settlement project, drawing wealth from occupied Syrian and Palestinian lands. Many see it as "an achievement of Zionism, because it combines Jewish settlement in the region with the region's economic development." Many also see winemaking in the Golan as an embodiment of Zionism, as it combines agriculture, settlement, and economic development..., thus strengthening the connection between the people and the land".
